Unfortunately I will be unable to attend the meeting since I have to speak at a public meeting being held in Bridgeport, CT starting at 5:00 pm. There wouldn't be enough time to get from New Bedford to Bridgeport to make the meeting.

There are few things that we are working on that I'll provide for the group info. We met with the USCG and the City to discuss the proposed South

terminal. There are a couple of concerns that we raised/identified.

We indicated that there can be no blocking of the roadway that allows us access to the hurricane barrier. Moving things across the roadway is fine but any fencing or placement of material on the roadway is not acceptable. We have been working with Chet from Apex to make sure that the proposed dredging will not impact the hurricane barrier. I currently have our geotechnical folks reviewing the proposed plan and cross section to make sure that we are comfortable that the proposed dredging will not impact the barrier revetment. We still need a determination from USEPA as to whether they consider this proposed terminal to be part of the SER. Until we are notified of that determination, our position is Corps and State permitting will be required for this facility.

We have conducted benthic sampling in the harbor as part of our Environmental Assessment of the proposed maintenance dredging of the Federal project. We have also provided the City a draft economic analysis that examined what channels that require dredging still have the commercial shipping that justifies maintenance of those channels. If you haven't been provided a copy of that economic document and are interested in looking at it please let me know and I'll get it to you.

If there are any questions for me please let me know and I'll try and provide answers prior to the meeting on the 30th. Thanks.
