EDF Renewable Energy supports the expansion of the New Bedford Terminal as part of Massachusetts' offshore wind development efforts. Offshore wind has tremendous potential to assist eastern states in meeting state renewable goals and help to combat global climate change. EDF Renewable Energy has more than 3 GW of offshore wind projects in operations, construction, or advanced development and is keenly aware of the need for qualified port facilities.

The investment in port infrastructure is key to the deployment and construction of offshore wind turbines.
