BOSTON . . . Plans for remedial action in the Acushnet estuary and adjacent land areas contaminated with chemical waste will be discussed at a public meeting to be held on May 18 at 7:00 p.m. at Fairhaven High School.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will present a Remedial Action Master Plan as revised following public and official comments on the draft plan submitted early in February 1983. A summary of the draft plan was mailed to more than 300 citizens who signed in at previous meetings or asked to be placed on the Superfund mailing list.

Presentations will also be made by the Massachusetts Departments of Environmental Quality Engineering and Public Health. Following the presentations, the meeting will break up into groups and citizens will be free to move from one to the other and question the government officials.
