Thanks for the response Dave. I realize that the state is the lead for the broader SER, but my understanding is when EPA was working with the State to develop the resource assessment/ARAR's for the site, they were acting as the lead federal agency - and the approval of South Terminal was the Federal action. Our EFH and ESA consultations were with EPA, so it seems like any follow up associated with these consultations for South Terminal (ie. winter flounder capping mitigation) should be with EPA. I do not mind receiving info from the state, but I think we should avoid commenting directly to the state on consultation related issues. I would be happy to discuss further.
