Cindy,

The fate of the silt curtains and weir nets continue to be a source of concern here. Around CAD cell 3, there are 26 sections of silt curtain/weir nets. Of the 26, only 9 were reported to be in good conditioning and functioning as intended, by south terminal it was only 4 out of 18. They suggest that there have been interactions between the 2 systems which has contributed to the problems. They have dutifully replaced torn/ripped sections and repositioned the weir nets to eliminate the interaction. Hopefully, these are just the normal start-up issues. We'll see. I have forwarded the fish deterrent monitoring to Sue Tuxbury at NMFS. In addition, I got a call from Kathryn Ford at DMF asking me about the status of the fish deterrent efforts. I'm not sure how plugged in DMF is to this effort if at all. She did say that if there was a problem and we needed to have a fish discussion, to just call her and pull NMFS in as well.
