Dear Mr. Fagan:

On behalf of, and at the request of Mayor Brian J. Lawler, Camp Dresser & McKee Inc. (CDM) has prepared this written response to your letter of May 11, 1984 regarding the Coffin Avenue CSO Discharge.

1. In February of 1984, an indepth field survey was conducted as outlined in Item #1 of CDM's February 8, 1984 letter. A copy of the field survey information as obtained in February is attached for your benefit and information.
- 2a. As can be determined from our February field information, we did not identify all tie-ins downstream of the Coffin Avenue Pumping Station. We do not see the pertinence of that information at this time and therefore have not included it.
- 2b,c. By definition, it appears that the following connections may be classified as illegal:

1. Pine Art Boat	50 gpd	- largely domestic
2. Revere Sink	73,000 gpd	
3. Star Plating	195,000 gpd	
4. Revere Sink	1,260 gpd	
5. Isotronics	25 gpd	- largely domestic
6. American Press	750 gpd	
7. Star Plating	75,000 gpd	
- 2d. We have included copies of summary information obtained as part of the City's industrial Waste Survey and Industrial Pretreatment Program. In view of the State's desire to ensure accurate and current information on these industries, we have enclosed a copy of a standard questionnaire to be sent to each of the above industries by registered mail. The results of these questionnaires are to be returned to the City by 1 August, 1984 - after which time, the information will be forwarded to your attention.

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- 2e. While the City will endeavor to identify and locate any other sources in the Coffin Avenue area which may be discharging directly to the Acushnet River, we do not have definitive information describing such sources at this time.

 Star Plating - 41 Coffin Avenue - 996-4006 - Mr. Jack Goldstein
 Isotronics - 12 Coffin Avenue - 997-4575

4. In view of the urgency of the proposed situation, the City intends to pursue the following course of action:
1. Finalize Sewer Design - July 1, 1984*
 2. Apply for Sewer Extension Permit - July 1, 1984
 3. Negotiate with Tilcon/Warren
 (Contractor on retainage with City) - July 1, 1984
 4. Initiate Construction (Upon receipt
 of sewer extension permit and
 completion of negotiations with
 Tilcon/Warren) - August 1, 1984

*Preliminary Sewer Design Plan attached.
