Counsel:

I am writing to inform you that we may be able to arrange for a series of visits to the New Bedford Harbor Pilot Study site for your consultants. It has come to my attention that your representatives from Rizzo Associates and GHR Engineering have been visiting the area of the site frequently over the past month, and have been invited onto the site occasionally by the site manager. In order to minimize any interference with the project while permitting your consultants some further access to the site, Frank Ciavatierra has asked me to propose the following arrangements.

Beginning as early as August 16 or 17, your consultants will be permitted to come onto the site on occasion to observe the progress of the work. Your consultants must let Frank Ciavatierra know in advance of any visit how many visitors will be attending so that he can make the appropriate safety arrangements. At each visit, the attendees will sign a log book identifying themselves, their company, and who they represent. Arrangements for a subsequent visit to observe further progress can be made at the end of each visit. If any of defendants' counsel intend to accompany the consultants on a visit, you must inform me or Charles Bering directly at least five days prior to

the visit. If either of us cannot attend that visit, then counsel must reschedule their visit to a time when we can accompany you.

If you are interested, please contact me or Charles Bering to schedule the first of these visits.
