
Re: New Bedford Harbor Superfund Site

Dear Mary:

I have communicated with my clients concerning what you told me earlier this week regarding EPA's schedule and the fact that there is additional material ready to be added to the administrative record but that, for administrative convenience, EPA would prefer to add it all at one time. The defense counsel have asked me to convey their strong interest in obtaining any information which EPA has deemed ready for public dissemination as soon as possible. Consistent with your stated desire to amend the administrative record index on only one occasion, we suggest that the information be provided to your public record depositories in Boston and New Bedford and to Rizzo Associates (on behalf of defense counsel) with an amendment to the record coming at a later date. Alternatively, supplements to the Administrative Record index can be provided.

Please call at your earliest opportunity to advise me when we may obtain the additional information which EPA has deemed ready to release.
