SUBJ: New Bedford-Posting Warning Signs for PCB's

A visit was made to the New Bedford Harbor area on July 23, 1981 to repost warning signs.

The three areas covered were New Bedford, Fairhaven and Dartmouth. These three town border the closure areas for the taking of lobster and bottom feeding fin fish.

Mr. Almeida, Shellfish Constable, Dartmouth, agreed to post the shoreline area in that community. He stated further that he had sent a lengthy list of lobster trap numbers that were found in the closure area to Mr. Crossman, Division of Law Enforcement.
