Hi Gary,

We have not provided reports for the collection of that information either because the final report was engineering in nature and did not provide any relevant permitting or archeological assessment value, or because no final product associated with the activity was necessary, and therefore, there was no product to forward to EPA:

1). The pile-driving pilot test information was conducted to collect additional engineering information and was not intended to provide any relevant information with regard to permitting or assessment of archeological resources. No samples were collected during this activity. The tribes were alerted and onsite so they could observe the

proceedings.

2). The borings collected in August 2011 were completed to collect additional samples for geotechnical analysis and were collected in the same location as previous borings had been collected; as a result, there was no need to re-catalog the soils. The tribes were alerted and onsite so they could observe the proceedings.

3). The vibracores in October 2011 were completed to collect additional samples for environmental analysis, and were also collected in the same location as previous vibracores has been collected; as a result, there was no need to re-catalog the soils. Again, the tribes were alerted and onsite so they could observe the proceedings.
