At our meeting earlier in the week, we discussed questions that the Region has about the timeline for the terminal development. I wanted to draw to your attention a statement at the top of page 26 of MassDEP's January 18, 2012 submission. Specifically, in the discussion of site control/site availability, which is one of the practicability criteria used to screen various alternatives, MassDEP states that in order for a facility to be practicable, it must be able to be utilized no later than late summer, 2012. When you clarify the timeline in light of the questions we have already posed, it would be helpful to clarify this statement as well.
