Good Morning Ann. We offer the following comments to the two questions you proposed yesterday:

1) Blasting to be limited to the November – February time frame to protect fish species including any Atlantic sturgeon that may be in the project area; and sequencing dredging to limit dredging in the deeper channel to that same time frame, and to limit to the maximum extent possible the dredging in the shallower areas to the June – November time frame.

From the outset, please be reminded that the Commonwealth presented to EPA that there is the possibility that blasting may be required; however, the Commonwealth has yet to determine whether it wishes to proceed down this pathway. Nevertheless, in keeping with our discussions with EPA, we submitted information concerning potential blasting activities, if such activities were to take place, along with mitigation measures. Unfortunately, the tight project schedule and ever evolving project sequencing constraints significantly constrain the Commonwealth's ability to limit construction sequencing at this time. Equally important to the Commonwealth is the observation that we have uncovered no documentation or information that supports the notion that Sturgeon have been found to be in the harbor. Nevertheless, we have modified the construction plans and specifications to include the employment of mitigation measures if dredging is to take place during the time frames mentioned above, along with a commitment to manage the project to avoid those timeframes to the greatest extent possible.

2) Whether the 22.73 acre size of the winter flounder habitat mitigation will definitely occur or only if the expansions at the request of the City occur; and similarly, whether the 14.91 acre size of the shallow subtidal habitat mitigation will definitely occur or only if the

expansions at the request of the City occur.

The commonwealth commits to undertake the 22.73 acre size of the winter flounder habitat mitigation.
