Hi Cindy,

I was in a class this morning and just got a chance to look at this. I apologize.

We have one proposed change from a quick initial review. We may have additional suggested changes, but can you consider this one for now?

The text currently reads:

6. In the event the exceedence occurs during an activity and in an area in which silt curtains are required from January 15 through June 15 in accordance with Section II.5, if all additional mitigation measures exercised in accordance with Section II.7, and compliance cannot be reestablished within 48 hours of the implementation of the additional mitigation measures, the work shall stop and may not resume again until

June 16.

We would like to just add the following to the end as follows: “the work shall stop and may not resume again until June 16, *unless the Commonwealth can demonstrate to the satisfaction of EPA that it has instituted measures sufficient to reestablish compliance, and EPA concurs that work may proceed with such measures .*”
