I want to alert you to the fact that in the revised final mitigation plan, the description of the endowment fund is still presented in the context of a mitigation bank (see the last page). Could you please revise that section and email a revised final mitigation plan? I'd rather you not send over a whole new set of CDs. If you could label both the plan and the file name with the word "revised" and a new date, that would be helpful.

Also, in the financial assurances discussion (page 64), the plan states that the performance security will be furnished to the SER Committee, but nothing is said about whom the construction security would be furnished. Could you please clarify? We still need to evaluate whether the Committee can even accept such a security, but for now I just want to get a clarification of the intent.
