I understand that Bettina will be coming with additional questions regarding the state enhanced remedy project. Bettina, if you could forward to all your specific questions prior to the meeting, that would be helpful. I believe that two of the questions include:

- Upland areas, including ancillary properties: has there been comprehensive archaeological monitoring that includes the latest plan including the new ancillary property additions? Is there a map of the final configuration (with parcel lines and map/lot numbers) and a completed archeological assessment of any new areas not included in the 2010 studies?
- Intertidal/Subtidal areas: Was there additional archaeological investigations of the potential work areas (including potential dredging of federal channel and additional deep draft dredging) and the widened channel that was mentioned in the last Woods Hole meeting? Are these additional studies included in the January 2012 report?
