USACE had an informal govt-to-govt meeting with the Aquinnah Wampanoag Tribe on Martha's Vineyard this past Tuesday. Our commander, COL Samaris was in attendance along with Dr. Georgeie Reynolds, Sr. Tribal Liaison from HQ USACE who was up for the week from DC. The purpose of these tribal meetings is to discuss issues of concern to the Tribes and examine USACE programs that may be available to them. We also discuss some of the projects that USACE is involved in.

One topic that did come up was the New Bedford State Enhanced Remedy work which is separate from the Superfund project. While the Tribe is satisfied as to the consultation and involvement to date on the Superfund work, they expressed frustration as to their level of involvement and consultation for the enhanced remedy project. We indicated that we would pass this information along to EPA, the lead Federal agency and mentioned to the Tribe that they can certainly contact EPA directly to discuss further. Bettina Washington, Aquinnah THPO indicated that she has been in contact with Mike Stover, EPA Regional Indian Program Manager on other topics but not on this project. Please note that this comes with no judgment on our part. We simply want to pass along this information to you. If we can be of assistance, please let me know.
