RESOLUTION to adopt the "Ashton-Pratt Corridor Redevelopment Plan"

Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Cumberland as follows:

Whereas: The Towns of Cumberland and Lincoln, Rhode Island were awarded a one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollar grant by the Environmental Protection Agency for the research, preparation and presentation of a Land Use Redevelopment Plan for the Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Superfund Site; and,

Whereas: the Towns of Cumberland and Lincoln hired the firm of Crossman Engineering to facilitate this process and draft the Plan; and,

Whereas: public consensus was generated through several public workshops, meetings and interviews with stakeholders and interested Town citizens, organizations and administrative staff; and,

Whereas: the recommendations contained in the Plan are reasonable and recognize both the historic growth patterns and the future needs of the Town of Cumberland; and

Whereas: this Plan provides the Environmental Protection Agency with the information needed to assist in properly establishing cleanup standards and design appropriate protective remedies for reuse and continued use of the land in and adjacent to the Superfund site.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Cumberland, as follows:

Section 1. THE CUMBERLAND TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY ADOPTS THE ATTACHED DOCUMENT TITLED ASHTON - PRATT CORRIDOR REDEVELOPMENT PLAN AND DIRECTS THE TOWN ADMINISTRATION TO FOLLOW THROUGH WITH THE PLAN'S IMPLEMENTATION.

Section 2. THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE BY THE CUMBERLAND TOWN COUNCIL.
