

# US EPA Progress Update- Sutton Brook Disposal Area Superfund Site

May 29, 2014

During the project EPA will provide updates on upcoming site activities as much in advance as feasible.

What residents should expect:

Site preparation and clearing activities are ongoing.

Going forward, the Site will be active and regular deliveries of materials, supplies or equipment will continue to occur at a low frequency (including loads of material to construct temporary roads). At this time it is expected that transport of fill involving significant truck traffic will begin in late June or early July. When significant truck traffic commences, police presence along the truck route is planned.

Town of Tewksbury representatives, Contractors and EPA met on May 28 regarding planning, traffic, and safety. Contractor and Town Engineer will survey truck route to identify locations where vegetation should be cut back for visibility/safety. Signs for truck route are being considered at the South St/Bridge St intersection, and Shawsheen St/Bridge St intersection.

The week of June 9 – The Site will be tied-in (connected) to the sewer line on South Street. Residents may see manhole work at the edge of the Site at South Street.

Wheel wash station (to limit tracking of dirt onto South Street) will be in place by June 5. Contract is in place with street sweeper to sweep South Street as needed during construction.

Operating hours will generally be between 7:00 am to 4:30 pm.

Looking further ahead, during July, it is expected that work will occur on the last 3 Sundays of the month. The work will occur in the central portion of the Site (not near any boundaries). Deliveries will not take place on Sundays. It is also expected that Saturday work, will start the same week as Sunday work. However, Saturday work will probably continue into the fall.
