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## INTRODUCTION

This document is the Index to the Administrative Record File for the Troy Mills Landfill Site Removal Action II. The Index cites site-specific documents and guidance documents used by U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) staff in selecting a removal action at the site.

The activities to be performed under this removal action include removing drums, free product, and (to the extent practicable under this action) the surrounding contaminated soils from the landfill. At a minimum, the soils left in the excavation areas will have no visible staining. All wastes will be shipped to Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA)-compliant treatment and disposal facilities. Excavated areas will be restored to promote a natural environment. Restoration activities will include backfilling the excavated areas with clean material and establishing a vegetative cover. In addition, sufficient soil sampling and analysis will be performed to enable assessment of the potential for leaching of residual contaminants into the groundwater.

Furthermore, manned security will be provided during non-working hours to control unauthorized access to the site during the removal action. Access roads to and from the landfill will be monitored and repaired throughout the duration of the removal action. A traffic control plan will be implemented to ensure the safety of residents who will be impacted by the removal activities.

In addition, based on the new site conditions, the temporary interceptor system will be re-evaluated and modified as needed during the removal action and after the completion of the drum and contaminated soil removal. The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) has agreed to provide operation and maintenance of the interceptor system.
