Major components of the RMP training:

- General review of RMP elements, common inspection deficiencies and tips on using RMP*eSubmit for on-line updates/corrections to your RMP. Answers to your questions about the Risk Management Program.

Security: The security at the front door entrance is the same as the airport security. There is a scanner that you will need to walk thru, no weapons will be allowed, and they will need to see your ID at the front gate before you park your vehicle.

Parking: There is a security gate as you drive onto the grounds of the Federal Building. You will need to show your driver's license, however you will not be given a visitor's parking pass, as there are designated parking for visitors (15 spaces along the back row of the front parking lot and 40 spaces in the back parking lot).
