AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTERS 15.80 AND 15.85 TO COMPLY WITH STATE I/M REGULATIONS AND TO COMPLY WITH DMV ELECTRONIC PROCEDURES.

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

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Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.80.010 is hereby amended to read as follows Section 1. (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

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15.80.010 General provisions.

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- C. Certificate of inspection. [BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2000, TWO VERSIONS OF T] The certificate of inspection shall [WILL] be [UTILIZED]:
 - 1 [2]. [A]A windshield sticker which is affixed to the lower left side portion of the interior front windshield. [A PAPER CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION THAT IS PRINTED BY THE EIS AND VALIDATED IN A MANNER IDENTIFIED BY THE I/M PROGRAM ADMINISTRATOR.]
 - 2. A certificate of inspection [AND] windshield sticker issued in accordance with the procedures specified in this chapter [THE I/M PROGRAM] DESIGN], not more than ninety (90) days previous, shall be required prior to vehicle registration or vehicle registration renewal with the state division of motor vehicles for all vehicles subject to the requirements of this chapter [THE I/M PROGRAM DESIGN].

Unless specifically approved by the program administrator, non-exempt vehicles shall obtain a certificate of inspection [AND STICKER] not more than ninety (90) days prior to the registration [RENEWAL] expiration date [OR NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR (365 DAYS) PRIOR TO CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP DATE].
 - 2. Motorists operating non-exempt vehicles shall have their vehicles inspected at a certified station by a certified mechanic and shall obtain a valid certificate of inspection [AND STICKER] within thirty (30) days of entering the municipality.
 - 3 [4]. Failure to comply with these emission inspection requirements may result in a fine of \$50.00 to \$1,000.00 as provided under section 15.05.120A of this title.

[A MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER MAY USE A CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION THAT WAS ISSUED WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS TO REGISTER A USED MOTOR VEHICLE IF:

For a vehicle to qualify for a waiver under this subsection, the vehicle shall be referred [BY THE STATION] to the referee facility by means of a properly completed referee referral form.

PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

As a result of this ordinance, in 2006 and in 2007 two-year old vehicles will not be I/M tested for the first time. Due to the mid-year implementation of changing I/M test frequency from annual to biennial in 1997, the number of vehicles tested in a typical even year is somewhat higher than in an odd year.

Reorganization of I/M and air quality staff as well as reduction in other direct and indirect charges will be necessary.

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The I/M test industry will see similar reductions in number of vehicles to be I/M tested. There may also be decreases in numbers of repairs performed on new vehicles, however many new vehicle repairs will continue to be performed by dealers on vehicles still under warranty. Vehicle owners may defer routine maintenance.

Owners of three and four most recent model year vehicles will save the cost of I/M tests and certificates. Should repairs and maintenance be deferred, those costs will also be saved.
