Program Requirements



- Must be 18 years or older.
- Be eligible for employment in the United States.
- Be willing to participate in a three-week unpaid training program, 8-9 hrs/day.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Physically able to lift 50 pounds.
- Be willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Able to pass a drug test.

A high school diploma or GED are preferred but not required.

Although experience is not required, we are looking for applicants with a valid CDL driver's license and/or experience operating front end loaders, skid steers, excavators, dozers and dump trucks.
