


## Fencing SVNRT Repository in Woodland Park

April 2015

In response to public request, the SVNRT repository in Woodland Park is getting a fence. In late summer 2015, workers will install a fence around this contaminated site. The fencing will help keep people away from contamination. Heavy metals in the area pose a risk to people's health. The site will be cleaned up as part of a future remedial action after completion of work in Ninemile. For now, the fencing will help reduce people's exposure.

The SVNRT repository was once owned by Hecla Mining Company. It was created as part of a 1997 cleanup action by the Silver Valley Natural Resource Trustees. The repository holds about 600,000 cubic yards of mine waste with heavy metals removed from Canyon Creek. The site is now owned by the CDA Work Trust.
