# Cleanup Review Has Started at FMC Corp. Yakima Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is preparing the fourth Five-Year Review of the FMC Corp. Yakima Superfund Site cleanup. The 4-acre site of a former pesticide formulation facility in Yakima, Washington, contained contamination from agricultural pesticides that were disposed of in an onsite pit.

## Background

The EPA's cleanup included removing contaminated soil from the site and cleaning a concrete floor in a warehouse so the building can be used for industrial purposes. The redeveloped site now has a combination of commercial and light industrial businesses.

Every five years, the EPA performs a review of the site to make sure the cleanup still protects people and the environment. The EPA will complete this Five-Year Review in September 2013.

This review will examine whether the cleanup at this site continues to protect people and the environment.

Since the last review, the EPA has put into place institutional controls at the site. These controls ensure that current and future activities on the property will not endanger people or the environment by preventing:

- Excavation into the contaminated soils.
- Use of the shallow groundwater aquifer.
