- Job readiness program
- Underemployed or unemployed individuals
- Provides training to begin a career in remediation
- Works with site contractors and provides job placement assistance

PARTNERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

- Local businesses, universities, community organizations, federal agencies
- Stakeholder buy-in is essential
- Can help with recruitment
- May be able to provide resources (training venue, office space, recruitment staff)



OUTREACH

Performed in conjunction with community partner.

- One-on-one meetings
- Presentations
- Community/faith-based organizations
- Flyer distribution
- Word of mouth



CANDIDATE RECRUITMENT

- Candidate orientations
- Document submission
- Program “tryouts”



TRAINING

Training needs are discussed with site contractors and courses are provided primarily by local organizations.

Examples include:

- Pre-Employment Skills
- 40-hour HAZWOPER
- OSHA-10
- CPR/First Aid
- Asbestos Abatement

JOB PLACEMENT

- Assists with job placement by working with site contractors
- No guarantees
- Earning a job and doing good work are up to each candidate



POST-GRADUATION

- Graduates required to stay in contact with staff for six months
- SuperJTI staff will communicate with work supervisors
- Provides marketable skills to begin a career


