Six Short Videos: The ***Clean Air, Healthy Villages*** Video Series is on a flash drive with six videos similar to what you might find on You Tube (less than 5 minutes long). The first is an Overview of the most common types of air pollution in rural Alaska. The other videos cover each major type of air pollution in more detail, along with ideas on how to protect family and community health.

Other Resources: The Toolkit also includes Outreach Ideas and room for additional resources, such as checklists, action steps, contacts, and other materials as they are identified or developed.
