Re: FY2015 first quarter reporting on Section 105 Air Planning Agreement grant commitments

Dear Mr. Worley:

After reviewing the reporting requirements listed in Table 1 of the FY 2015 Section 105 Air Planning Agreement Reporting Requirements, the Division for Air Quality reports the following for the first quarter:

1. ID# 15-03: Due Date 11/15/14: Enter all quality-assured Air Toxics data, including UATMP and other special toxics monitoring projects and associated QA/QC data, into the AQS database. *For carbonyls and VOCs, the ERG laboratory has reported data for all samplers through June 30, 2014. For PM₁₀ metals, the ERG laboratory has reported data for all samplers through May 31, 2014.*
2. ID# 15-04: Due Date 11/15/14: Asbestos data report – manually report number of notifications received; number of inspections; non-notifier activity, if applicable; number of non-penalty enforcement actions; number of enforcement actions with an assessed penalty; and total penalty assessment. *KY AHERA Grant Status Report for the reporting period of April 1, 2014 – September 30, 2014 was submitted on November 14, 2014.*

3. ID# 15-05: Due Date 11/15/14: List of PSD/NSR applicability determinations resulting in major source non-applicability. *EPA receives copies of complete permit packages for PSD and NSR in non-attainment areas. Synthetic minors and sources that net out of applicability, including both federally enforceable and state origin permits, are also sent to EPA. In cases where no permit applies and the DAQ concurs, then DAQ will notify EPA of the circumstances.*
4. ID# 15-08: Due Date 11/15/14: Submit annual reports on progress of sections 111(d) and 129 plans. *The Division for Air Quality has not promulgated any new 111(d) or 129 plans for FY2015.*
