REGULATION 3.01 Purpose of Standards and Expression of Non-Degradation Intention

Air Pollution Control District of Jefferson County Jefferson County, Kentucky

Relates To: KRS Chapter 77 Air Pollution Control

Pursuant To: KRS Chapter 77 Air Pollution Control

Necessity And Function: KRS 77.180 provides that the Air Pollution Control Board may make and enforce all needful orders, rules, and regulations necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of KRS Chapter 77. This regulation states the purpose of District standards and an expression of non-degradation intention of the Air Pollution Control Board.

SECTION 1

Ambient air quality standards mean those levels of air quality which the Board judges are necessary, with an adequate margin of safety, to protect the public health and welfare from any known or anticipated adverse effects of air pollution. Such standards are subject to revision, and additional standards may be promulgated as the Board deems necessary to protect the public health and welfare.

SECTION 2

In the establishment of these standards, it is the intention of the Board to prohibit further significant and avoidable deterioration of air quality in areas where air quality presently exists which is numerically equal to or is better than the standards expressed herein.

SECTION 3

No person shall violate, or interfere with the attainment or maintenance of, ambient air quality standards as specified in this regulation.
