

Rule 14. Nuisances.

Rule 14.1. No person shall cause, suffer, allow or permit or fail to take reasonable steps to abate or terminate the discharge from any source whatsoever of air contaminants or other material which shall cause injury, detriment, nuisance, or annoyance of the public or which endanger the comfort, repose, health or safety of the public or which cause or have a tendency to cause injury or damage to business or property.

Rule 14.2. No person shall cause, suffer, allow or permit or fail to take reasonable steps to abate or terminate the discharge from any source whatsoever air contaminants or water or steam or a combination of such which cause, or combine with natural elements to cause, the reduction of visibility across any road or thoroughfare to such an extent as to cause a hazard.

Rule 14.3. Nothing in any other section of this regulation relating to regulation of emission or pollutants shall in any manner be construed as authorizing or legalizing the creating or maintenance of a nuisance as described in this Rule 14 of this regulation or as may otherwise be deemed by law to be a nuisance.
