

37.0 SEPARATION OF EMISSIONS

37.1 General

If air contaminants from a single source operation are emitted through two or more emission points, the total emitted quantity of any air contaminant limited in these regulations cannot exceed the quantity which would be the allowable emission through a single emission point; and the total emitted quantity of any such air contaminant shall be taken as the product of the emission points and the exhaust gas volume through all emission points, unless the person responsible for the source operation establishes the correct total emitted quantity.
