



We Are Cleaning Up in Your Area

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will be in your neighborhood cleaning up hazardous waste located at the former Carrier-Bryant site. Here is some important information you should know about this work:

- The neighborhood will be safe from cleanup activities. We make careful plans and use monitoring instruments to ensure public health is protected.
- EPA actions should be completed next February.
- The city of Indianapolis is planning additional cleanup work at the property after EPA is finished.
