The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Michigan Department of Environmental Quality and the city of Detroit will hold a community meeting to explain plans for yard and neighborhood soil cleanup on Fairview Street in Detroit. The meeting will be at 4 p.m. Friday, Nov. 2, at The Samaritan Center, 5555 Conner Ave., Detroit. Recent soil sampling found several yards are contaminated with lead from historical industrial operations at the former Federal Mogul property.
