The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Michigan Department of Environmental Quality and the city of Detroit will hold an open house to discuss with residents the soil cleanup this spring on Fairview Street in Detroit. The open house will be:

You may come as your schedule allows during the open house to talk with government officials about the lead sampling and cleanup.

Soil sampling done in 2012 found several yards are contaminated with lead from historical industrial operations at the former Federal-Mogul property. Clean up of the soil will begin in late March.
