

Update on Site Progress

Operable Unit (OU) 1: Allied Landfill

- Millennium continues to work on this OU
- Groundwater investigation is on-going
- Feasibility Study to be submitted in early Fall

OU 2: Willow Boulevard/A-Site Landfills

- EPA currently negotiating a Consent Decree to implement the remedy at OU 2 with Georgia Pacific
- Anticipate remedy design and implementation will occur with field work occurring over the next two field seasons

Update on Site Progress

OU 3: King Highway Landfill

- Georgia-Pacific continues to implement the remedy at this OU

OU 4: 12th Street Landfill

- Weyerhaeuser is the Responsible Party at this OU
- EPA reviewing landfill cap design
- Anticipate cap construction to begin later this summer

Update on Site Progress

OU 5: River

- Millennium has ceased work on the River
- Under existing AOC Georgia-Pacific is responsible for all Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) work
- Georgia-Pacific has indicated they will meet all RI/FS obligations under the AOC
- All field investigation work under the SRI/FS is on-going and on schedule
- Expedited work at the Plainwell #2 Dam area is currently on hold
- EPA evaluating CERCLA authorities to pursue implementation of Plainwell #2 Dam project
- EPA will continue discussions with Georgia Pacific and Stakeholders on possible expedited work downstream

Update on Site Progress

Mill Properties

- Weyerhaeuser is continuing work on the RI/FS at the Plainwell Mill
- Georgia-Pacific Kalamazoo and Former Hawthorne Mills source investigation report is under EPA review
- Path forward for source investigation at three other Mill properties as required by the 2007 AOC is being evaluated by EPA
