I called Ms. Cathy L. Altman with the Division of Hazardous Waste Management at the Southwest District Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) office regarding the Carboline Company facility in Xenia, Ohio. Ms. Altman stated that she conducted the Ohio Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) Final Inspection of the Carboline Company facility on January 22, 2001. Ms. Altman confirmed that no violations of Ohio CRO laws were identified and that all equipment and materials that could be removed at the facility had been removed. She also stated that there was no information in the OEPA file for the Carboline Company facility in Xenia, Ohio regarding any subsurface investigations at the solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOCs) identified during the 1992 preliminary assessment and visual site inspection (PA/VSI) or any closure documentation relating to these units and areas.
