Motors Liquidation Co., under the supervision of U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 5, will conduct an indoor vapor intrusion investigation in about 60 homes and buildings southwest of the former General Motors manufacturing complex. The tests involve sub-slab and indoor air sampling. MLC needs access agreements from property owners before conducting the tests that will check whether hazardous vapors are seeping into homes and buildings. MLC plans to start the sampling this March.

The meeting will be held Thursday, Feb. 17, 6 – 8 p.m., at the Moraine City Council Chambers, 4200 Dryden Road. At the meeting, EPA representatives will discuss the status of the indoor investigation. **EPA emphasizes it needs access agreements from property owners before the indoor sampling can take place.** EPA urges the property owners in the Riverview Platt neighborhood to sign the access agreement and return them to MLC. Access forms will be available at the meeting for residents to fill out.
