RACER Trust under the oversight of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and local and state partners has been conducting an air testing program in the area southwest of the former GM plants neighborhood to investigate the presence of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in sub-slab soil gas and indoor air samples.

At the meeting, representatives from EPA will discuss the current status of the indoor investigation. EPA emphasizes it needs access agreements from property owners before the indoor sampling can take place. Access forms will be available at the meeting for residents to fill out.
