- U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 5 invites the public to submit comments on proposed changes to the cleanup plan for the Dana Corp. site in Roscoe. The site was formerly known as Warner Electric.
- EPA will hold a public meeting on Sept. 15, 2010 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at North Suburban Library District, Roscoe Branch, 5562 Clayton Circle, Roscoe, IL.
- EPA will review written comments submitted from Sept. 1 to Sept. 30 before making a final decision on the proposed changes.
- The proposed changes call for phasing out a system that has been treating polluted underground water supplies at the site. The system is no longer needed because the underground water meets drinking water standards.
