



**Your Comments Wanted
On EPA's Proposed Cleanup Plan
Dow/Flexible Products Site
Crest Hill, Illinois**

Public Comment Period: Nov. 26 – Jan. 3, 2011

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 5 is proposing to contain and clean up pollution at the former Dow/Flexible Products factory site by demolishing a building, periodically removing a hazardous contaminant from underground water supplies and maintaining the existing cover over a former quarry. EPA picked its preferred cleanup plan from several options presented in an official document called a "statement of basis." The statement of basis and other documents about the Dow/Flexible Products site are available for review at the Crest Hill Public Library, 1298 Theodore St.

EPA will not select a final cleanup plan until after the Agency reviews statements received from the public during the **public comment period Nov. 26 – Jan. 3, 2011.**
