**NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF A CORRECTIVE MEASURES DECISION** is hereby given that on September 15, 2006, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) proposes to issue a Corrective Measures Decision under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) to Clean Harbors of Cleveland, for its facility located in Cleveland, Ohio and that the U.S. EPA will be accepting comments on the proposed decision.

The proposed decision, which provides for institutional controls, is issued under the provisions of Section 7004(b) of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. 6974(b). A public notice will appear in **The Daily Legal Newspaper on September 13, 2006** and a radio announcement can be heard on **WNCX radio on September 13, 2006 between 6:00am and 10:00am**. The U.S. EPA is soliciting input from the community on the proposed corrective measures decision for the Clean Harbors facility. The U.S. EPA has scheduled a public comment period starting on September 14, 2006 and ending on October 30, 2006, in order to encourage public participation in the corrective measures decision process. During the comment period, U.S. EPA will accept written comments on the proposed determination.

Any person interested in submitting comments on the proposed decision must do so by **October 30, 2006**. All comments and any request for a public meeting should be submitted in writing to:

After the close of the public comment period, the U.S. EPA will select the final Corrective Measures and provide notification of its decision and rationale, to all persons who have submitted written comments, in a “Final Decision and Response to Comments” (“Final Decision”) document.
