Group (NACG), Lordstown Assembly Plant and Metal Fabricating Division (MFD),  
Lordstown Metal Fabricating Plant, in Lordstown, Ohio.**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has overseen Corrective Action activities at the General Motors Corporation, North American Car Group (NACG), Lordstown Assembly Plant and Metal Fabricating Division (MFD), Lordstown Metal Fabricating Plant. The Statement of Basis explains the proposed remedy for addressing any contaminated soil, surface water, sediment, or groundwater at the facility. The Statement of Basis also explains the rationale for selecting the remedy and summarizes any other remedies evaluated. The U.S. EPA will select a final remedy for the facility after a 45-day public comment period has ended and any additional information that was received has been reviewed and considered.

The U.S. EPA is issuing this Statement of Basis as part of its public participation responsibilities under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).
