NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF A CORRECTIVE MEASURES DECISION is hereby given that on June 6, 2006, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) proposes to issue a Corrective Measures Decision under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) to General Motors Corporation (GM), for its Centerpoint Business Campus facility located in Pontiac, Michigan, and that the U.S. EPA will be accepting comments on the proposed decision.

The proposed decision, which provides for institutional controls, LNAPL cleanup and further investigatory requirements, is issued under the provisions of Section 7004(b) of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. 6974(b). A public notice will appear in The Daily Oakland Press newspaper on June 5, 2006 and a radio announcement can be heard on WJR 760am radio on June 5, 2006 between 6:00am and 10:00am. The U.S. EPA is soliciting input from the community on the proposed corrective measures decision for the GM facility. The U.S. EPA has scheduled a public comment period starting on June 6, 2006 and ending on July 21, 2006, in order to encourage public participation in the corrective measures decision process. During the comment period, U.S. EPA will accept written comments on the proposed determination.

Any person interested in submitting comments on the proposed decision must do so by July 21, 2006. All comments and any request for a public meeting should be submitted in writing to:

Copies of the corrective measures proposal, investigatory reports, remedial reports, and other relevant documents, including the Statement of Basis, are available for public inspection and copying during the public comment period by visiting the **Pontiac Public Library, located on 60 East Pike Street in Pontiac, Michigan**, during regular business hours.

These materials and other supporting documents which make up the administrative record, are available for viewing at the U.S. EPA Region 5 office identified above from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. After the close of the public comment period, the U.S. EPA will select the final Corrective Measures and provide notification of its decision and rationale, to all persons who have submitted written comments, in a “Final Decision and Response to Comments” (“Final Decision”) document.
