NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF A PROPOSED CORRECTIVE MEASURES DECISION is hereby given that on August 6, 2009, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) proposed to issue a corrective measures decision under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) to Univar USA Inc. for its facility located at 59865 Market Street, South Bend, Indiana (U.S. EPA Identification Number IND 016 627 333), including commercial and residential properties north of the facility, and that the U.S. EPA will be accepting comments on this proposed decision.

The proposed decision provides for enhanced biodegradation of ground water contamination, which originated from the Univar facility to within acceptable drinking water levels. Previous actions which have been taken include the connection of affected commercial and residential properties to City of South Bend drinking water supply, and the removal of contamination by a soil vapor extraction system on the Univar property. The proposed decision also requires restrictive covenants be placed upon the Univar property deed. This public notice is issued under the provisions of Section 7004(b) of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. 6974(b). A public notice will appear in the *South Bend Tribune* on August 6, 2009. The U.S. EPA has scheduled a public comment period starting on August 7, 2009, in order to encourage public participation in the corrective measures decision process. During this comment period, U.S. EPA will accept written comments on the proposed determination, and will schedule a public meeting if one is requested. The public comment period will end on October 9, 2009.
