On March 31, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 5, issued the Federal portion of a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit for the above-referenced facility. When both this portion of the permit and the State of Ohio's portion of the permit become effective, Heritage-WTI, Inc. will have an effective RCRA permit.

This letter transmits the enclosed Response to Comments generated as a result of the public notice for the draft permit. This Response to Comments was prepared by EPA and sent to interested parties.

I have made the final decision to issue the Federal portion of the RCRA permit for this facility located in East Liverpool, Ohio. Unless review is requested under Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) §124.19, the Federal portion of the RCRA permit becomes effective on May 1, 2009.

Appeal to the Federal RCRA permit is described in 40 CFR §124.19. The administrative appeal procedures must be completed prior to any action seeking judicial review. All original documents are to be signed in blue ink with five (5) copies marked as such. The petition for review must be received by U.S. EPA in Washington D.C., via U.S. Postal Service at the address indicated below within 33 days after service of notice of the final decision.
