on the
Clean-up of Contaminated Groundwater at
PLM Properties, Inc. (Formerly SPECO)
Springfield, Ohio**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) is managing environmental corrective action at PLM Properties Inc. (PLM) (the former SPECO facility) in Springfield, Ohio. The corrective action is being performed by PLM under the authority of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). The Statement of Basis prepared by U.S. EPA provides a summary of PLM's investigation of contaminated groundwater at and from their facility, as well as a summary of PLM's study of viable remedies. This Statement of Basis also specifies the remedy proposed by U.S. EPA to clean up contaminated groundwater at and from the facility.

U.S. EPA is issuing this Statement of Basis as part of its public participation responsibilities under RCRA. A fact sheet summarizing the proposed remedy, along with other site related documents, may be found in the information repositories located at:
