Invites the Public to Comment on the  
STATEMENT OF BASIS for the Selection of Proposed Final Remedy for  
CORRECTIVE MEASURES at the former Stewart-Warner site  
(ID # IND 005 213 715)  
located at 1514 Drover Street  
In Indianapolis, Indiana**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has overseen Corrective Action activities at the site. The Statement of Basis explains the proposed remedy for addressing any contaminated soil, surface water, sediment, or groundwater at the facility. The Statement of Basis also explains the rationale for selecting the remedy and summarizes any other remedies evaluated. The U.S. EPA will select a final remedy for the facility after a 30-day public comment period has ended and any additional information is received has been reviewed and considered.

The U.S. EPA is issuing this Statement of Basis as part of its public participation responsibilities under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). More detailed corrective action information and reports and other site related documents contained in the administrative record for this facility are available for review at these *two* locations:
