**PROPOSED REMEDY TO ADDRESS CONTAMINATED GROUNDWATER,
SOIL, AND INDOOR AIR AT THE
DELPHI CORPORATION (Formerly General Motors) FACILITY LOCATED AT
480 NORTH DIXIE DRIVE HIGHWAY, VANDALIA, OHIO**

U.S. EPA is managing environmental corrective action at the **Delphi Corporation facility located in Vandalia, Ohio** under the authority of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). A Statement of Basis prepared by U.S. EPA provides a summary of Delphi Corporation's investigation of environmental contamination at and from their facility. It identifies the remedies proposed by U.S. EPA to cleanup contamination and protect human health and the environment.

U.S. EPA is issuing the Statement of Basis as part of its public participation responsibilities under RCRA. Detailed reports and other documents supporting the Proposed Remedy are contained in the Administrative Record which can be viewed at the:
