U.S. EPA is managing environmental cleanup at the **Solutia Inc. facility located in Sauget, Illinois** under the authority of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. U.S. EPA has prepared a Statement of Basis that provides a summary of Solutia's investigation of environmental contamination at their facility and identifies remedies proposed by U.S. EPA to cleanup contamination, and protect human health and the environment.
