



**EPA Announces  
Public Comment Period  
for the Wayne Disposal Landfill  
Proposed PCB Modification**  
Belleville, Michigan

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency plans to approve a request from Wayne Disposal Inc. for a modification to the company's existing chemical waste landfill approval for disposal of polychlorinated biphenyls, or PCBs. Approval would allow WDI to expand its PCB disposal capacity an additional 11.73 million cubic yards at the company's Wayne Disposal Landfill in Belleville, Mich. The expansion would occur within the original boundaries of the facility. The EPA regulates PCB disposal under the federal Toxic Substances Control Act.

Before EPA makes a final decision, the Agency will review written public comments submitted during the **comment period** that runs from **July 8, until midnight August 8, 2013**. EPA will also consider requests to hold a public meeting. Send comments to:
