

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0027375

The permittee is authorized to discharge from a facility located at the Rio de Arenas Mobile Home Manor to Rio de Arenas in NM Water Quality Standards Segment (WQSS) 20.6.4.98 NMAC - Intermittent Waters, thence to San Vicente Arroyo an ephemeral water in the Mimbres River Closed Basin. The discharge is located at Latitude 32° 46' 25" N and Longitude 108° 11' 29" W, in Grant County, New Mexico. The designated uses of the receiving water are livestock watering, wildlife habitat, marginal warmwater aquatic life and primary contact.

Under the SIC Code 6515/ NAICS 531190, the applicant operates a sewage treatment plant or facility. The facility has a design flow capacity of 0.04 MGD serving a residential population of 250. This is a renewal of a NPDES permit with an effective date of October 1, 2009, and an expiration date of September 30, 2014.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
